Market & Pantry

Being able to provide food to feed yourself and your family is a basic human need. Finding yourself in a place where you are food insecure is a scary thing.

One of the main ways the Real Life Center assists our clients is by providing the fresh food and nonperishable items that they need to help feed those in their household. In both the market and pantry, we strive to make the shopping experience an enjoyable and dignifying one.

Mobile Food Pantry

Through our partnerships with Atlanta Community Food Bank and Grace Church, we are able to offer a mobile food pantry once a month. Clients come from all over Georgia to receive fresh food.

Financial Assistance

Our financial assistance program continued to play an essential role in giving individuals and families the boost they needed to get back on their feet in 2022.

With inflation continuing to rise, along with other difficult life circumstances, we saw the need for assistance grow. The top reasons new clients came to the Real Life Center throughout the year included health issues, job loss, and divorce.

Job Assistance

With job loss or lack of a job being one of the top hindrances our clients faced in 2022, our job coaching and referral services proved to be vital in addressing their immediate needs. These services are designed to assist in the development of job search strategies, tools and marketing plans, and referrals to reduce the transition time it takes to find employment.

We are thankful to have business partners in our community who have interviewed and/or hired Real Life Center clients after our referral.

Helping Hand Grant

Another way the Real Life Center can help individuals become more economically stable is to assist them with starting their own business. This is a great option for clients who want to make extra income on the side or have a passion they want to pursue and eventually turn into a career.

Starting a business can be a financial burden, so the Helping Hand Grant was created to help offset some of the costs. Approved applicants can receive financial assistance to aid in the start-up process, and have access to our volunteer business mentors who meet with them one-on-one to offer guidance along the way.

Clothing Closet

Clothes can be expensive - especially when you have multiple people living in your household. Our clothing closet consists of new or very gently used clothing items along with shoes, linens, and towels.

For many of the clients we serve, the clothes in the clothing closet not only provide them with a new wardrobe, but also allow them to allocate the funds that would have gone toward purchasing clothes to other needs.

Chaplaincy Services

At the Real Life Center, our mission is to provide those in need with holistic care, which means we care for each person physically, emotionally, relationally, financially, mentally, and spiritually.

Caring for the spiritual needs of our clients is the cornerstone of our chaplaincy services. We focus on caring for these spiritual needs through three main avenues: pastoral care, classes, and chapel services.
